

Handicap proof.

- **Maximum handicap** allowed on the golf course: **35**.
- Players must show **updated Spanish Federation Golf Card**. If the player doesn't have one, a **Handicap Certificate** from his/her club of origin must be shown. If a **Handicap Certificate** is **not available**, the **pro staff** may **decide** if the **player** is "officially" **qualified** for play on the golf course.

Etiquette.

- **Repair** pitch marks the proper way. **Replace** divots on fairways and topdress divots on tee boxes. **Rake** bunkers and proper rake placing.
- Shout "**fore!**".
- No **bad behaviour** allowed.
- Repeated **offences** of any of these points may result in the **Visitor** being **ejected** from the facilities with **no** right of a **refund**. For **Members** the **Disciplinary Regime** will be applied.

Pace control.

- **All players** in the flight **must** be at the 1st/10th tee (or the correspondent hole, in case of shot gun start) **ready for play** at the time booked.
- Mark and identify your ball.
- **Keep up** with the **group in front** of you and play as soon as it is safe to do so. Your position on the course has to be **right behind** the **previous group** and not just in front of the following group.
- **Maximum** time allowed for a round of golf: **4h 45min (18 holes)**, 2h 30 min (front 9), 2h 15 min (back 9).
- When you think your ball is **OB** or lost, take a **provisional ball**.
- When playing around the **green**, leave your **bag** on the **closest** way to the **next tee**.
- **Don't count** your shots and/or **note** your score **down** until you get to the **tee** of the **following hole**.
- **Mark your ball** on par 3 greens, put yourself in a safe place (i.e. on hole number 5 go to the back of the green) and let the following group tee off. Finish the hole as the following group walks towards the green.
- **Ring the bell** on hole 6.
- **Only 5 minutes** ball searching.
- **No ball fishing**. The player is allowed to collect only his/her own ball.
- **No mobiles permitted**, except in case of emergency. In case of having to use the **mobile**, the player has 2 choices: **stand aside** and rejoin his group at the point they are, or the group has to **let** the following **groups through**.
- **No stop** after 9 holes. Toilet break is permitted. If there's a delay of more than 5 minutes, let the following group through.
- **Sharing** golf equipment is totally **forbidden**.
- Repeated **offences** of any of these points may result in the **Visitor** being **ejected** from the facilities with **no** right of a **refund**. For **Members** the **Disciplinary Regime** will be applied.

Buggies.

- **Must stay on the paths**. Must never be parked on collars, tee boxes or tee slopes (this also applies to hand and electric trolleys or any bag carrying device).
- Any player with a **proven transitory or permanent physical handicap** will be handed a "**blue flag**" which will allow him/her to use the **90 degree rule**, and will have to go **back to the path** immediately after the shot.
- People **under 18** are **not allowed to drive buggies**. However, they can be the 2nd passenger. **Only 2 people per buggy**.
- Racing and dangerously driving is strictly forbidden.
- **No buggies** allowed with **persistent rain** or when the greenkeeper considers the **course** is **too wet**.
- Repeated **offences** of any of these points may result in the Visitor being **ejected** from the facilities with **no** right of a **refund**. For **Members** the **Disciplinary Regime** will be applied.

Thunder & lightning.

- If a **hooter** is blown, **mark** your ball and **take shelter**. When the weather is settled you will be let back on the course, and play may be continued after another hooter sound.
- **No refund** if "**Weather Watch**" was **notified** and play had to be cancelled for the rest of the day or delayed to the point of not being able to complete the round.

Invitees must always **play with** the member that **invites** them.

Dress code.

- Caps.
 - All caps with a peak must be worn with the **peak at the front.**
- Shirts.
 - Golf shirts **must have collars**, with either long or short sleeves.
 - **Collarless** shirts allowed if they are from any **golf** recognised **brand.**
 - Shirts do not have to be tucked in.
 - **Rugby/football** shirts are **prohibited**, as well as **beach wear.**
- Trousers.
 - Must be **tailored** and appropriate for **golf.**
 - **All types or colour of denim, paramilitary or camouflage style trousers, combat trousers (multiple pockets), tracksuits or jeans are strictly prohibited. No patch pockets permitted**, other than recognised golf manufactured clothing.
 - It is **not permitted** to wear **trousers tucked into socks.**
- Shorts.
 - **Tailored** shorts (no patch pockets) may be worn subject to being **not more than 10 cm above the knee.**
 - **Beach wear, short shorts, training shorts and athletic shorts are not permitted.**
 - **No patch pockets permitted**, other than recognised golf manufactured clothing.
- Socks.
 - Shorts and trousers **must** be worn **with socks**, which, if long must be of a single plain colour.
- Shoes.
 - Use golf shoes with **soft spikes. Trainers** with no colourful additions are also **permitted**
 - **No metal spikes permitted.** A spike changing service is available in the Pro-shop.
 - **No sandals** of any variety are permitted.
- Ladies.
 - Collarless shirts/tops must have sleeves and sleeveless shirts/tops must have collars and must have a modest neck line (no more than 10 cm below the neck).
 - Any **beach wear, Halter tops** and **Tank tops** are **not permitted.**
 - Trousers/slacks, tailored shorts and golf skirts/culottes are permitted.
- **If the player does not comply with the dress code he/she will no be allowed in the facility.** For **Members** the **Disciplinary Regime** will be applied.
